(Applicant Tracking System)
What Is It?



ATS | What is it?

Software applications that enable the electronic handling of recruitment needs: applications, resumes, cover letters, etc. An ATS can be accessed online through a company's website.

Companies use an ATS to manage and screen resumes.

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Growth of the ATS

76% of job seekers use company's career websites to apply for jobs.

... yet ATS can lead to 48% of applicants dropping out of the process.



Get Past the ATS

- Don't be fancy
 - Fonts
 - Formatting
 - Visuals
- Look for keywords
- •Stay on the 1st page



Don't fall into the trap!

 Too much time on Twitter and FB will have you focusing on the wrong things

 Social media can give you insight in to things quickly if used effectively. You need to make sure you are using it to gather information first and foremost

94% of companies use it for recruiting

Social Media | LinkedIn

- Keywords
- Professional photo
- Ask for recommendations...sparingly
- Articles beware
- Join groups
- Follow companies



Social Media | Facebook

54% of companies use it for recruiting

- Search for passive candidates
- Create interest in jobs
- Search for active candidates

58% of companies use it for screening candidates



Social Media | Facebook

- •Fill out your professional history
- Use your network
- Learn about companies' cultures—BUT don't be fooled



Social Media | Twitter

39% of companies use it for recruiting

31% of companies use it for screening candidates

Practice Interviewing

Be ready to discuss.....

- Accomplishments?
- Relationship with your boss
- Reason for looking....were you fired? Laid off?
- Compensation
- Work ethic



Phone Interviews



Phone Interviews

- Use a land line
- Apologize in advance if using a mobile phone
- Limit distractions
- Know procedure if the call is dropped
- Speak clearly
- Pay attention to your speed
- Have a high energy level



Before the Call











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During the Call

- Where to look
- Smile
- Stay present
- Pose



Technical Issues

•If the video drops?

Keep going

•If the whole call drops halfway through?

Try to reconnect the call

•If the call never connects at all?

Interviews

- Be comfortable: dress appropriately
- Minimal jewelry
- No cologne/perfume
- •Blue, gray, white, blue
- No water bottles or Starbucks
- Pace yourself
- Always accept water



The Big Secret...

 Ask good questions that will help you decide if you want to work there and will show you're intelligent

 Ask the same questions to everyone you meet if they are applicable



Relationships



Build new relationships

- Attend local professional events
- Take a class
- Find career role models





Maintain existing networks

- Connect on LinkedIn
- Touch base for no reason





Utilize networks for your search

- Reach out to old classmates
- Contact former coworkers
